The Gliding Federation of Australia (Gliding Australia), together with the Air Sport Australia Confederation (ASAC), have the pleasure to invite the National Gliding Teams from all active FAI Members to participate in the 37th FAI World Gliding Championships for Standard, 15m & Club Class gliders.

1) The Venue

Narromine is located on the Western Plains of NSW in Australia due West of the Great Dividing Range, 38 kilometres (20-minutes by road) from the major inland city of Dubbo. The country is mainly farmland, flat with small hills to the North and East. The topography and soil structure provides excellent thermals, often to over 10,000ft.

The site is operational 7 days a week with a full-time tug pilot and instructor available. Pilots and teams are welcome to come to Narromine prior to the contest calendar start.

4) Pre-Event Practice/Training

Narromine Gliding Club operates 7 days a week throughout the summer months. A least one full time tug pilot is employed for this period. NGC will provide launches and assistance to visiting pilots.

The Narromine Cup event will be run in November and all visiting pilots are welcome to enjoy this fun event.
