

NOTE: A request for the adjustment of the entry fee (up to 1000€) and aerotow charges (up to 80€) has been submitted to the IGC and will be decided by the Plenary Meeting held on 6-7 March 2026. In recent years, there has been a significant change in the FAI sanction fee per pilot and per competition compared to the amounts in effect at the time of the bid submission. In addition, prices driven by higher than expected inflation rate and soaring labour costs in our country have increased substantially. The final amounts will be published in the Local Procedures. If the increase in the entry fee is approved, we will ask for an outstanding amount to be paid during on-site registration at the airfield by 15 May 2026, 20:00, at latest.

ACCOMODATION:

A campsite for tents and camper vans with access to electricity and sanitary facilities will be available at the airfield. High-speed WiFi internet access will be provided. There will also be a designated area for team tents with access to electricity.

Camping Fees

Tent - 15€/day (up to 3 pers.)
Camper/Caravan - 25€/day (up to 3 pers.)

More than 3 person - 10€/day/person

The competition website provides links to recommended camper/caravan rental companies that have been supporting our competitors year after year to ensure good rest between contest days.

Restaurant "Tazza"

During the Championships, on-site catering will be provided by the Tazza restaurant. The following services will be available:

- Breakfast buffet: approximately €13 per person.
- À la carte service: available throughout opening hours.

ELECTRIC GLIDERS & CARS

E-Gliders

We will provide a limited number of parking stands equipped with charging points for electric motor batteries of electric self-launch/sustainer gliders. We do not anticipate providing individual power access for charging avionics batteries for every glider.

Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging at the Airfield

- EV charging will be available on site at the airfield
- Availability is limited and operated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Users must provide their own certified charging cables/adapters

GENERAL CONTEST INFORMATION

Competition Area

The Championships will be flown across Poland and Czechia.

Meteorological Conditions

- Expected thermal tops/lift below FL95; oxygen is not required.
- Anticipated usable lift heights during the event: 1,000–2,500 m AMSL
- In the Częstochowa area, May is typically mild: average daily temperature around 14°C, with typical night minima of 8–9 °C and daytime maxima of 18–19 °C. Short cold spells with ground frost as well as warm episodes with > 25 °C are possible. Under cloudbase temperatures below 0°C are common in May

Outlandings

- Field aerotow retrieves are not permitted in Poland.
- Returns from outlandings are possible only from other aerodromes or registered airfields (as published in the Turnpoint database).
- From unprepared fields: ground/trailer retrieve only.
- In May, crops are low and do not pose a hazard to outlandings.

Aerotow Ropes

Aerotow ropes will be provided by the Organiser.

Airspace

- The competition area includes permanent and temporarily activated airspace structures.
- The Organiser will brief daily on the status and availability of individual airspace elements.

War in Ukraine

- Providing that the situation will not escalate beyond current status we don't expect direct impact of the warfare behind the Polish eastern border on championships.
 Substantial airspace limitations stretch along the Polish eastern border, but these don't reach closer than 120 kms from the competition site to the east.
- GPS jamming and spoofing occurs in northern and north-eastern Poland, generally along the border with Russian Kaliningrad Oblast, and don't protrude closer than 200 kms to the north from the competition site.

Legal requirements for gliders and pilots from outside EU/EEA

Gliders are subject to national requirements of the country of registration regarding certificate of registration, certificate of airworthiness and radio license. Pilots must hold a valid license issued, recognized or accepted by the country in which the glider flown is registered, accompanied by the documents required there (e.g. aeromedical certificate, radiooperator certificate, etc.).

Required third party liability insurance sum is not subject to the above exception and shall abide by EU requirements set out in Regulation of European Parliament and Council no. 785/2004. The insurance sum required depends on MTOM of the aircraft as follows:

MTOM < 500 kg
 MTOM <1000 kg
 750'000 SDR
 1'500'000 SDR

To fly a competition in Poland pilots <u>not holding</u> PART-(S)FCL compliant licences shall apply for recognition of the licence to the Polish Civil Aviation Authority (ULC). Such a recognized license may be used on any glider registered in an EU/EEA country. Detailed information about the process in both Polish and English is available at:
